CAC Awards:

In alignment with our organization's goal to diversify our community and include new voices and perspectives, we have established two awards that cover the full cost of attending a CAC workshop. BIPOC & LGBTQIA2+ artists are welcome at Creative Arts Community and are encouraged to apply!

Awardees will receive:

- Full scholarship including shared room and board
- Special feature at the pop-up gallery during the two workshop weeks
- Opportunity to give an artist talk in Wright Hall during their workshop week
- Recognition on our website
- 1. **CAC Emerging Artist Recent Grad Award**: To qualify to apply, you must be a recent graduate (within 3 years) or a graduating senior / final year MFA student from any art or design program in Oregon or Washington. You must also be 21+ years old by the time of the workshop. **Click here to apply.**
- 2. **CAC Art Teacher Professional Practice Award**: To qualify to apply, you must be an art teacher (.5 or higher) at a PK-12 school. You must also be 21+ years old by the time of the workshop. **Click here to apply.**

CAC Need-Based Scholarships:

CAC offers five partial scholarships a year based on financial need. They are \$350, which covers the cost of basic tuition. Scholarship recipients are still responsible for paying for their lodging and any class material fees. BIPOC & LGBTQIA2+ artists are welcome at Creative Arts Community and are encouraged to apply! New applicants to our program, teachers, & BIPOC applicants are given priority consideration. **Click here to apply.**

You will need the following information to apply for one of the financial need-based scholarships:

- 1. A brief statement in response to the following:
 - a. Why you are hoping to attend Creative Arts Community: What is it about our organization and workshops that is compelling to you?
 - b. Your reasons for requesting financial assistance: What are the circumstances/financial barriers that would prevent you from attending?
 - c. Your current interests: What activities or organizations are you involved in? How would this experience benefit you and/or other communities?
 - d. List two personal or professional references with emails and/or phone numbers.
