About the Program

DucksRISE (Research, Internship & Student Engagement) is a new six-month, cohortbased program focused on bringing into effect equitable post-graduation outcomes for underserved students at UO, centering BIPOC, first generation, and low-income students. DucksRISE fosters community building and a sense of belonging through educational activities, career exploration and readiness, professional development, tailored connections, and mentorship experiences. Students will develop career skills and competencies through a one-credit upper-division career readiness seminar followed by a flexible experiential opportunity.

Eligibility

Currently enrolled UO students of any class standing who self-identify as BIPOC, first gen, and/or low-income.
